Philadelphia, PA and Surrounding Areas

Company and Location:

- Company-Swimming pool management company
- **Community**-Population of about 1.5 million people.
- Location-Largest city in Pennsylvania. Located in the South-Eastern part of Pennsylvania.
- **Weather-**Hot and humid during the day, warm and humid during the evening. Temperatures range between 70 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit (24-38 degrees Celsius)



Job Positions:

- Pool Attendant/Lifeguard-Will be assigned a pool upon arrival. Will be responsible for monitoring activities at the pool facility. Must provide constant dedicated surveillance of the pool, rescue swimmers in danger, test the chlorine levels, clean the pool and pool area (including bathroom), and administer first aid.
- Pay Rate-\$8.75 per hour
- Hours-Approximately 40 hours per week, modified pool schedule during first 2-3 weeks due to local schools still in session.
- Start Date-May 23rd
- End Date-September 8th
- Must work FULL program dates!

Employment Conditions:

- Advanced English skills for interacting with swimmers and pool patrons.
- Must be able to work outside in all weather conditions, especially heat and sun.
- Must pass Red Cross Certification in your home country.
- Must pass pool operator exam or retest upon arrival, cost (up to \$100) will be payroll deducted.
- Will be tested regularly on lifesaving, CPR and First Aid.
- **Social Security Number**-Approximately seven days after you check into the program you will apply for a social security card. You will be able to work before you receive your card.

Housing and Transportation:

- Overview of housing situation-Located in the area where you will work. Furnished apartment or hotel with kitchen.
- **Housing Fees-**\$100.00 per week, payroll deducted.
- Additional Housing Fees-A housing deposit of \$150.00 plus the first 2 weeks of rent are due prior to arrival (\$350.00 total). Each apartment will have a housing utility allowance, \$75 for 2 bedroom, \$90 for 3 bedroom. Monthly utilities that exceed this allowance will be split between residents and payroll deducted.
- **Transportation-**You will walk, bike, bus or take the metro to work each day. Bike fee, \$100, payroll deducted, non refundable. Linen fee, \$30, payroll deducted, non refundable.
