#### **Additional Comments:**

We work hard and play hard!!! Housing will be on-site at all 4 lodge locations in Custer State Park.

WAGES: Here is an example of the pay breakdown:

Dishwashers and Housekeepers receive \$1100 per month plus the value of the dormitory room and the three meals a day, seven days a week has a value of \$600 so our company believes that the position has a value of \$1,700. However this is what it looks like in their pay check.

\$1100 per month paid every two weeks

\$1100 x 12 equals the annual salary because our payroll system is on an annual basis \$13,200

The \$13,200 is paid over 26 pay periods

\$507.69 is what shows as the gross in their paychecks. This is for a 48 hour work week. Or 96 hours in the pay period.

How (Our Company) arrives at an hourly rate:

\$1,100 \$ 600

 $\frac{$1,700 \times 12 = $20,400}{$1,700 \times 12 = $20,400}$  divided by 26 pay periods = \$784.62 which would be for 12 days in the pay period so it is

\$65.39 per day or \$8.17 per hour as they all work an 8 hour shift.
